It has 2 turbines with a nominal power of 325 MW each, providing a total capacity of 650 MW. The elevated reservoir is situated on top of the Dlouhé Stráně mountain, 1,350 m above sea level and the head of turbines is 510 m.
- Karlova Studánka – a small spa (mineral water)
- Štramberk – the picturesque little town is known as “Moravian Bethlehem”
- 17.00 – arrival to Vsetín, students - host families , teachers – hotel
- 18.30 – dinner in a hotel
