Information technology specialists translate specialist requirements into complex hardware and software systems. they analyse, plan and produce information technology and telecommunications systems and introduce new or modified systems. They provide customers and users with technical advice, support and training. Typical areas of applications development in which they work are commercial, technical, expert, mathematical and multimedia systems.

Typical areas of system integration in which they work are computing centres, networks, client/server systems, fixed networks and radio networks.

- commission information technology and telecommunications systems,
- apply project planning, implementation and control methods,

- present system solutions,
